The Behavioral Branch is the specialized unit that directs all mental health referrals, and supervises offenders with mental illnesses and co-occurring disorders. CSOSA's Specialized Supervision Teams work together with community based resources such as the District of Columbia Department of Mental Health and its Core Service Agencies. Located throughout the District of Columbia, the Core Service Agencies provide routine mental health care to offenders in his/her communities.
