On December 9, 2010, the Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA) convened a Called to Action Forum. From this event, a City-Wide Advisory Council was formed to address four barriers related to re-entrants: Employment, Education, Housing and Addiction and Health assistance. Notably these are important issues, but the needs of the victims are also paramount.

Workgroups were formed to address the issues and barriers. Workgroup #1 – Called to Serve–Victims of Crime has developed *“Called to Serve”*, a one day training event for faith-leaders, laity, mentors, and mentees. The purpose of the training is to address issues of lethality, crime prevention, grief counseling, conflict resolution, and crisis intervention and how does the faith community respond.
