## **CSOSA Director Nancy M. Ware Expresses Thoughts on the Life and Legacy of Paul A. Quander, Jr.**

WASHINGTON, DC – Nancy M. Ware, Director of the Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency (CSOSA), expressed her sincerest condolences to the family of Paul A. Quander, Jr. for their recent loss.

“Paul’s legacy in the District is one of longstanding and dedicated service,” Director Ware noted. “Paul was proud to be CSOSA’s first director. He was very serious about and committed to the work of improving public safety in the nation’s capital.”

Mr. Quander’s career of public service in the District included a most recent position as Deputy Mayor for Public Safety and Justice under former Mayor Vincent Gray. He also served as an Assistant United States Attorney for the District of Columbia and as the Deputy Director for the D.C. Department of Corrections. Mr. Quander began his professional career working for Neighborhood Legal Services, representing indigent clients in public benefit administrative hearings, landlord and tenant civil actions, and in various small claims trials.

During his term at CSOSA, Mr. Quander served as Co-Chair of the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council for the District of Columbia and through this role he helped to strengthen CSOSA’s active partnerships with the Metropolitan Police Department, the United States Attorney’s Office for the District of Columbia, the Federal Bureau of Prisons, the United States Parole Commission, the United States Marshals Service, as well as other local and federal agencies.

“We at CSOSA will do our part to honor Paul’s memory and legacy. We will continue our commitment to serving the people of the District by improving outcomes for individuals on supervision while balancing the interests of public safety,” Ware added.
