





**Distribution of District of Columbia Inmates*
housed in a BOP facility
by State and Gender**

- On May 27, 2010, there were 5,605 inmates housed in facilities managed by the Federal Bureau of Prisons (BOP) following adjudication in DC Superior Court. The states with the highest population of DC offenders were Pennsylvania (938), North Carolina (674) and West Virginia (549).
- Ninety-six percent (5,357) were males. The leading three states housing male inmates were Pennsylvania (899), North Carolina (672) and West Virginia (488).
- Four percent (248) were females. The leading three states housing female inmates were Connecticut (68), West Virginia (61) and Pennsylvania (39).

NOTE: This fact sheet does not include 410 inmates who were in-transit to or from a BOP facility.
