





**Distribution of District of Columbia Inmates \*  
housed in a BOP facility  
by State and Gender**

- On September 30, 2010, there were 5,440 inmates housed in facilities managed by the Federal Bureau of Prisons (BOP) following adjudication in DC Superior Court. The states with the highest population of DC offenders were Pennsylvania (854), North Carolina (747) and West Virginia (548).
- Ninety-five percent (5,191) were males. The leading three states housing male inmates were Pennsylvania (814), North Carolina (747) and West Virginia (482).
- Five percent (249) were females. The leading three states housing female inmates were Connecticut (69), West Virginia (66) and Pennsylvania (40).

*NOTE: This fact sheet does not include 501 inmates who were in-transit to or from a BOP facility.*
