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- Length of Time on Supervision
  - 50% have been on supervision for 0.94 years
  - 10% have been on supervision for 3.93 years
- Remaining Supervision Obligation
  - 50% have at least 0.99 year remaining
  - 10% have 5.08 years remaining
- Supervision Type
  - 20% Parole
  - 31% Supervised Release
  - 46% Probation

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- Average Caseload
  - 50 to 1 in General Supervision
  - Roughly 35 to 1 in Special Supervision
- Supervision Intensity
  - \* 9% place on GPS since November 1, 2009
  - \* 50% supervised at Intensive/Maximum
    - 58% percent are on ACTIVE status
    - 11% of offenders have an active warrant
    - 15% are in jail or being detained
- Supervision Branch
  - 50% General Supervision
  - 18% Mental Health
  - 10% Domestic Violence
  - 8% HIDTA
  - 6% Interstate-In
  - 6% Sex Offender
  - 2% Traffic-Alcohol

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## Top Four Types of Arrest or Convictions

- 30% Drug Abuse Violations
- 9% Weapons; Carrying, Possessing, Etc.
- 8% Other Assaults
- 8% Robbery

# Abuse and Mental Health Service Needs

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## Substance Abuse Service Needs

- 29% Treated for a substance abuse related condition within the past six months
- 25% Evaluated for a substance abuse related condition within the past month
- 26% Sought substance abuse counseling within the past month

## Mental Health Service Needs

- 29% Ever been evaluated for or diagnosed with a mental disorder
- 28% Experience bouts of anxiety and/or depression
- 30% Feel that he/she can benefit from mental health counseling/therapy
- 19% Currently in a mental health treatment program
