- Average Caseload
  - 50 to 1 in General Supervision
  - Roughly 35 to 1 in Special Supervision
- Supervision Intensity
  - \* 9% place on GPS since January 1, 2010
  - \* 51% supervised at Intensive/Maximum
    - 58% percent are on ACTIVE status
    - 12% of offenders have an active warrant
    - 14% are in jail or being detained
- Supervision Branch
  - 50% General Supervision
  - 18% Mental Health
  - 10% Domestic Violence
  - 8% HIDTA
  - 6% Interstate-In
  - 6% Sex Offender
  - 2% Traffic-Alcohol

## Substance Abuse Service Needs

- 29% Treated for a substance abuse related condition within the past six months
- 25% Evaluated for a substance abuse related condition within the past month
- 27% Sought substance abuse counseling within the past month

## Mental Health Service Needs

- 29% Ever been evaluated for or diagnosed with a mental disorder
- 28% Experience bouts of anxiety and/or depression
- 31% Feel that he/she can benefit from mental health counseling/therapy
- 19% Currently in a mental health treatment program
