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- Length of Time on Supervision
 - 50% have been on supervision for 0.92 years
 - 10% have been on supervision for 4.38 years
- Remaining Supervision Obligation
 - 50% have at least 0.9 year remaining
 - 10% have 4.83 years remaining
- Supervision Type
 - 19% Parole
 - 25% Supervised Release
 - 52% Probation

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- Average Caseload
 - 50 to 1 in General Supervision
 - Roughly 35 to 1 in Special Supervision
- Supervision Intensity
 - * 8% place on GPS since January 1, 2010
 - * 41% supervised at Intensive/Maximum
 - 64% percent are on ACTIVE status
 - 12% of offenders have an active warrant
 - 10% are in jail or being detained
- Supervision Branch
 - 50% General Supervision
 - 18% Mental Health
 - 10% Domestic Violence
 - 8% HIDTA
 - 6% Interstate-In
 - 6% Sex Offender
 - 2% Traffic-Alcohol

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Top Four Types of Arrest or Convictions

- 29% Drug Abuse Violations
- 9% Other Assaults
- 8% Weapons; Carrying, Possessing, Etc.
- 6% Robbery

Abuse and Mental Health Service Needs

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Substance Abuse Service Needs

- 26% Treated for a substance abuse related condition within the past six months
- 23% Evaluated for a substance abuse related condition within the past month
- 26% Sought substance abuse counseling within the past month

Mental Health Service Needs

- 21% Ever been evaluated for or diagnosed with a mental disorder
- 22% Experience bouts of anxiety and/or depression
- 23% Feel that he/she can benefit from mental health counseling/therapy
- 16% Currently in a mental health treatment program
