 - 7% Separated/Divorced
- Employment Status
 - 37% Employed

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- Length of Time on Supervision
 - 50% have been on supervision for 0.93 years
 - 10% have been on supervision for 3.73 years
- Remaining Supervision Obligation
 - 50% have at least 1.05 year remaining
 - 10% have 5.02 years remaining
- Supervision Type
 - 20% Parole
 - 29% Supervised Release
 - 49% Probation

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- Average Caseload
 - 50 to 1 in General Supervision
 - Roughly 35 to 1 in Special Supervision
- Supervision Intensity
 - * 10% place on GPS since January 1, 2010
 - * 52% supervised at Intensive/Maximum
 - 71% percent are on ACTIVE status
 - 8% of offenders have an active warrant
 - 9% are in jail or being detained
- Supervision Branch
 - 50% General Supervision
 - 18% Mental Health
 - 10% Domestic Violence
 - 8% HIDTA
 - 6% Interstate-In
 - 6% Sex Offender
 - 2% Traffic-Alcohol

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Top Four Types of Arrest or Convictions

- 32% Drug Abuse Violations
- 9% Weapons; Carrying, Possessing, Etc.
- 9% Other Assaults
- 7% Robbery

Abuse and Mental Health Service Needs

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Substance Abuse Service Needs

- 26% Treated for a substance abuse related condition within the past six months
- 19% Evaluated for a substance abuse related condition within the past month
- 23% Sought substance abuse counseling within the past month

Mental Health Service Needs

- 22% Ever been evaluated for or diagnosed with a mental disorder
- 22% Experience bouts of anxiety and/or depression
- 24% Feel that he/she can benefit from mental health counseling/therapy
- 15% Currently in a mental health treatment program
