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- Length of Time on Supervision
  - 50% have been on supervision for 0.89 years
  - 10% have been on supervision for 4.17 years
- Remaining Supervision Obligation
  - 50% have at least 0.88 year remaining
  - 10% have 4.75 years remaining
- Supervision Type
  - 20% Parole
  - 21% Supervised Release
  - 55% Probation

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- Average Caseload
  - 50 to 1 in General Supervision
  - Roughly 35 to 1 in Special Supervision
- Supervision Intensity
  - \* 11% place on GPS since February 1, 2010
  - \* 41% supervised at Intensive/Maximum
    - 72% percent are on ACTIVE status
    - 9 % of offenders have an active warrant
    - 7% are in jail or being detained
- Supervision Branch
  - 50% General Supervision
  - 18% Mental Health
  - 10% Domestic Violence
  - 8% HIDTA
  - 6% Interstate-In
  - 6% Sex Offender
  - 2% Traffic-Alcohol

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## Top Four Types of Arrest or Convictions

- 25% Drug Abuse Violations
- 10% Weapons; Carrying, Possessing, Etc.
- 8% Other Assaults
- 7% Robbery

# Abuse and Mental Health Service Needs

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## Substance Abuse Service Needs

- 22% Treated for a substance abuse related condition within the past six months
- 18% Evaluated for a substance abuse related condition within the past month
- 20% Sought substance abuse counseling within the past month

## Mental Health Service Needs

- 17% Ever been evaluated for or diagnosed with a mental disorder
- 18% Experience bouts of anxiety and/or depression
- 19% Feel that he/she can benefit from mental health counseling/therapy
- 13% Currently in a mental health treatment program
