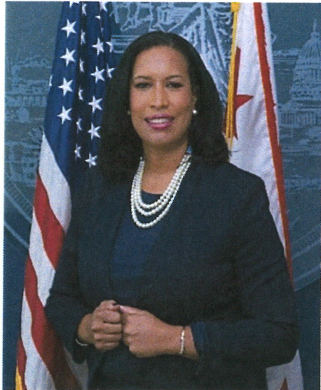


Proclamation



PRETRIAL, PROBATION AND PAROLE SUPERVISION WEEK

JULY 19-25, 2026

WHEREAS, we observe Pretrial, Probation and Parole Supervision Week each year during the third full calendar week of July to celebrate and honor the nation's more than 90,000 corrections professionals; and

WHEREAS, corrections professionals change lives and enhance public safety by monitoring individuals on pretrial release, probation, or parole and connecting them with treatment, education, employment and other essential resources that reduce recidivism; and
